
<u>Chamber Books Project</u> <u>Task 5: What role did money play in securing the reign of Henry VII?</u>



In this self-guided session you will:

- Use the evidence you have gathered from the Chamber Books database yourself and the views of the historians to build your own argument;
- Synthesise (bring together) large amounts of primary and secondary material to make a coherent case;
- Experience taking on the role of the Historian yourself and reflect on the skills you have learnt.

Review: How important was money in securing Henry VII's reign?	
What role did money play in keeping Henry's reign secure? (Remember to refer to your evidence!)	
Did his spending change over time? Why do you think this was/ was not the case? What can this tell us?	

Does your research confirm that Henry was an avaricious (money-grasping) King? Or is this reputation unfair?	
What have you learnt about how Historians carry out their research and make their argument?	
What challenges did you encounter when taking on the role of the Historian and how did you overcome these?
